

### Who are the Ambassadors?

Study Abroad Ambassadors are a group of Mercer students, who after their return from a study abroad program, commit to becoming student leaders oncampus through outreach and promotion of Mercer's study abroad opportunities.



### Responsibilities:

Study Abroad Ambassadors promote international opportunities available at Mercer. They represent the Office of Global Education during in-person and online events including Study Abroad Week, Saturday Preview Days, UNV 101 classroom visits, etc..

### Requirements:

- Applicants must have completed at least one Mercer Abroad program (e.g. faculty-led, spring break, exchange, affiliate, or internship. This does not include Mercer on Mission)
- Able to assist the Office of International Programs on a volunteer basis for at least two study abroad events during the semester (excluding events occurring during Study Abroad Week).
- Commit to following university and office protocol regarding standards, policy, and procedure.
- Passionate about contributing to an increasingly global society.
